#### **Travel Assistance**

Cancer Council Queensland (CCQ) supports the ongoing professional development of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health workers and other health professionals working with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. The two-day program will support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Workers in providing cancer care, prevention, screening and early detection, and end of life care.

To support your employees to attend the Caring for Our Community Course, Cancer Council Queensland has Travel Assistance available. The Travel Assistance provided is a contribution to the cost of attending the course and may not cover all expenses to attend. Recipients are encouraged to reduce costs wherever possible.

#### **Application Process**

Participants will need to register for the program using the Application Package and complete the travel assistance documentation below. There is no cost to register for the course. Your organisation is responsible for submitting the documentation in full. Cancer Council Queensland will work with you to complete the documentation where needed.

#### **Application Amount**

The Cancer Council Queensland Travel Assistance is for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health workers living and working as health professionals in Queensland.

Cancer Council Queensland has available one-off travel assistance valued **up to** \$1000 AUD (including GST) to successful applicants for participants to attend the Caring for Our Community Course. The amount approved will be dependent on an assessment of the travel, accommodation and meal expenses relevant to your region and the Travel Assistance pool of funds available. The travel assistance is a contribution to the cost of attending the course and may not cover all expenses to attend and recipients are encouraged to reduce costs wherever possible. The Travel Assistance will be paid via Electronic Funds Transfer prior to the course.

We understand that costs may change slightly between when you apply for the travel assistance and when you make bookings. The final amount of the travel assistance provided will be determined by Cancer Council Queensland and will be based on the information outlined in your application and a discussion between Cancer Council Queensland and the participant. Please outline the anticipated costs for reimbursement based on the costs at the time of completing this application. Participants are advised to keep their receipts and to provide them to Cancer Council Queensland if requested to do so. If participants are unable to attend the course, or if costs to attend reduce, applicants will be asked to repay funds to Cancer Council Queensland (in full or the difference in amount). When returning to the workplace, it is expected that health workers will use their learning experiences to contribute to improved cancer outcomes across Queensland.

- Be a health worker living and working in Queensland at the time of the course
- Be able to provide information to networks within their communities after the course
- Live more than 50km from the course location and require financial assistance to be able to attend the course

#### **Selection Process**

Once received, the applications will be reviewed for completeness. The CCQ Travel Assistance Selection Committee will meet to evaluate the submitted applications and may call for additional information in order to reach a final decision. Each applicant will be notified via email of the outcome within two business days of receiving all required information. Late applications received may be considered if funding remains.
